

NOTICE OF REFERENDUM VOTE

TO: THE ELECTORS OF THE FISHING LAKE FIRST NATION

TAKE NOTICE that a referendum vote of the **electors** of the Fishing Lake First Nation (the “First Nation”) pursuant to subsection pursuant to subsection 38(2) and section 39.1 of the *Indian Act* and the *Indian Referendum Regulations* relating to Reserve lands, and pursuant to section 6 of the *Claim Settlements (Alberta and Saskatchewan) Implementation Act* relating to Pre-Reserve Lands, will be held on the **14 day of September, 2017** on the Fishing Lake Indian Reserve No. 89 to seek the assent of the majority of electors of the First Nation to the Designation of the First Nation and its members’ potential future rights and interests in certain portions of the Settlement Pre-Reserve lands and the First Nation’s rights and interests in certain Reserve lands, for leasing purposes as set out in the attached Designation Documents.

The following four (4) questions will be placed before the electors by secret ballot:

BALLOT NO. 1 – Fishing Lake First Nation Designation Gas Station and Convenience Store: Reserve Surface Lands

An application to change the voters list shall be made, at any time, to the Electoral Officer.

The *Indian Referendum Regulations* also state that an elector may vote either in person at a polling station or by mail-in ballot, but not both.
